Collaborative and Coherent Research Community

- Expand membership of the Palliative Care Research Network
- Organise and promote the 9th Palliative Care Research Network Symposium
- Organise, promote and deliver the EAPC International Public Health Research Seminar 2020

Research Leadership and Capacity

- Expand membership of the Early Career Researcher Forum and support members to transition to the Palliative Care Research Network
- Build research capacity by providing regular information on funding calls, career, knowledge sharing and networking opportunities
- Nurture talent by delivering events for potential research leaders including online webinars and opportunities for dissemination
- Partner with funders and Palliative Care Research Network members for funding calls and capacity building
- Deliver research prioritisation/research support events between hospices/clinical sites and Palliative Care Research Network members
- Collate members research interests aligned to Top 10 Research Priorities

Service User, Carer and Community Involvement

- Continue to support researchers to engage with service users and carers throughout the entire research process, from the research design stage to output stage
- Provide training for Voices4Care members at a Voices4Care event to enable them to have more meaningful involvement in research

Disseminate Research Knowledge

- Continue to support and promote Knowledge Transfer and Exchange (KTE) using KTE model EMTReK including developing an online module on the Palliative Hub Learning Platform
- Continue to provide support and training to network members to represent their research and successfully interact with service users, carers, healthcare professionals, policymakers, funders and other researchers
- Facilitate a workshop on implementation of research into practice and policy
- Continue to support members to use traditional and non-traditional KTE methods with project webpages, publications, blog articles, and publishing members work across social media platforms and at oral presentations at AllHPC and partner events

Palliative Care Research Network Sustainability

- Identify funding calls and support PCRN members to respond to and lead on national and international funding calls including ECRF members where appropriate
